

A BASIC GUIDE FOR YOUR SEE YOU AT THE POLE™

(This is intended to be only a simple guide. Be creative. Do whatever your group is led to do.)

The 2020 theme verse for *See You at the Pole™* is 2 Kings 23:25.

“Josiah . . . turned in total and repentant obedience to God.

A young man named Josiah began one of the greatest revivals and awakenings in the Old Testament. Josiah had become king of Israel at the age of eight. Scripture tells us that at the age of 16, he began to pursue God passionately. Like his forefather, David, he began to show signs of godliness early on and gained the respect of the people. This resulted in radical obedience of getting rid of everything that did not honor God and challenging everyone around him to do likewise. These actions resulted in a mighty movement of God in his day—actually, one of the greatest ever!

Here are some things you can pray for:

1. Pray for students all over the world who are gathering in other nations. There are some who are in countries where they have little to no religious freedom. Many may be hungry with not enough to eat. Let's pray for all students gathered with us today around the globe.
2. Pray for our nation and government.

6. Pray for those in the prayer circle with you.
